## The Suburban Concert Band History



The band was started in 1983 by Howard Emerson, Supervisor of Music in the West Allis-West Milwaukee Public Schools, as a non-profit adult organization under the auspices of the West Allis-West Milwaukee Recreation Department. The band got off to a very good start and when Mr. Emerson retired in 1985, Henry Canitz, Director of the Milwaukee Pops Youth Band and a director in the West Allis-West Milwaukee Public Schools with many years experience was appointed as director. Under his leadership, the band has maintained its present membership of approximately forty outstanding musicians.

The Suburban Concert Band performs an average of seven times each season from September through May and it prides itself in selecting music that is both challenging to the musicians and interesting to the audience.

Members come from throughout the Greater Milwaukee Area and range from eighteen to seventy-nine years of age. ## Our Conductors



Henry Canitz is a product of Wisconsin. He was born in Milwaukee, and attended Milwaukee schools. He has also lived in New Berlin and West Bend. He earned his Bachelor's Degree from UWM and his Masters Degree from VanderCook College of Music in Chicago.

He taught music in Milwaukee and West Allis and his students achieved numerous outstanding awards. In 1959 he organized the Milwaukee Pops Youth Band which he directed for 31 years. In 1985 he took over the directorship of the outstanding Suburban Concert Band. This is his 20<sup>th</sup> year with the Band, and his 55<sup>th</sup> year as a director. He has received many awards, including National Band Associations "Citation for Excellence" Award. In addition to this, he managed, with the help of his wife, Arlene, to raise seven outstanding children.

Robert Rothwell is a graduate of UW-M and he earned his Master Degree from Northwestern University. He taught for 29 years at Mt. Prospect, Illinois. Mr Rothwell plays professionally on both the piano and french horn. A private student of Mr. Canitz, he played in the "Milwaukee Pops Youth Band". Now retired, he plays in many bands and orchestras, including the Suburban Concert Band. He has twice been nominated for the Outstanding Teacher Award.
